With a robust hull and fit-out by Hardy, this vessel is designed to provide a safe and enjoyable boating experience. This compact yet spacious cruiser offers a well-considered layout from stern to bow, ensuring comfortable accommodation and functionality for extended trips.

At the heart of Compass Rose lies the powerful Volvo AQAD41a diesel engine coupled with a duoprop 290 outdrive, ensuring efficient and reliable performance on the water. This setup promises both power and manoeuvrability, making it a pleasure to navigate through various water conditions. The addition of a bow thruster further enhances the handling, providing precise control during docking and tight manoeuvres.

The Compass Rose boasts accommodation for up to four berths, making it ideal for small groups or family outings. The interior is designed with practicality in mind, featuring a galley equipped with a cooker, sink, and fridge, ensuring you can prepare meals with ease. The lounge and dinette areas provide comfortable spaces for relaxation and dining, though specific descriptions are not provided, these areas are likely designed to maximize space and utility.

Ensuring a safe and smooth journey, the Compass Rose comes with a Boat Safety Certificate valid until August 2027. The vessel is fitted with a new battery as of May 2016, supporting its 12v and shore power electric supply. The blown air heating system offers comfort during cooler weather, while the full rear canopy, new in 2013, provides protection from the elements.

The boat is equipped with a chemical toilet, with plumbing in place for a sea toilet if preferred. Hot water supply is managed via a 12v system, ensuring a steady flow of cold water throughout the vessel. The new fuel tanks, each approximately 30 gallons, alongside a new water tank, exhaust, impeller, and steering helm, underscore the recent upgrades aimed at enhancing the boat's reliability and functionality.

Compass Rose is a versatile and well-equipped cruiser, offering a blend of comfort, safety, and reliable performance. Whether you're planning a leisurely day trip or a more extended cruising adventure, this Hardy 25ft cruiser promises to meet your needs with its thoughtful design and comprehensive features.
